•Multi-band satellite images: Data sources, layer stacking; combination: Standard FCC; •Band rationing: preparing NDVI, NDWI & Other indices; •Geo-referencing: standard; from map canvas input; Creating vector layer: points, lines & polygons; •Handling attributé table: Joining csv data layers; •Preparation of cartograms: bar, pie, choropleth; • Working with DEM: contouring & preparing different morphometric indices; •Land use & land cover map preparation: Use of Semi-automatic digital classification tool; • Map composition & layout.
